As you know, the Museum is housed in an elegant Edwardian building, a historical monument. It was built in 1906 as the Bacteriological Institute and later renamed the Pathological Institute. Since its opening in 1996, the Museum has received more than 250,000 local and overseas visitors and 3,500 school and community groups. Besides displaying permanent exhibits in 15 galleries and maintaining a herbal garden of medicinal plants, the Museum also holds regular thematic exhibitions. In 2004, the Museum was the recipient of the 'Award of Merit in Heritage Preservation and Conservation' presented by Antiquities Advisory Board.
